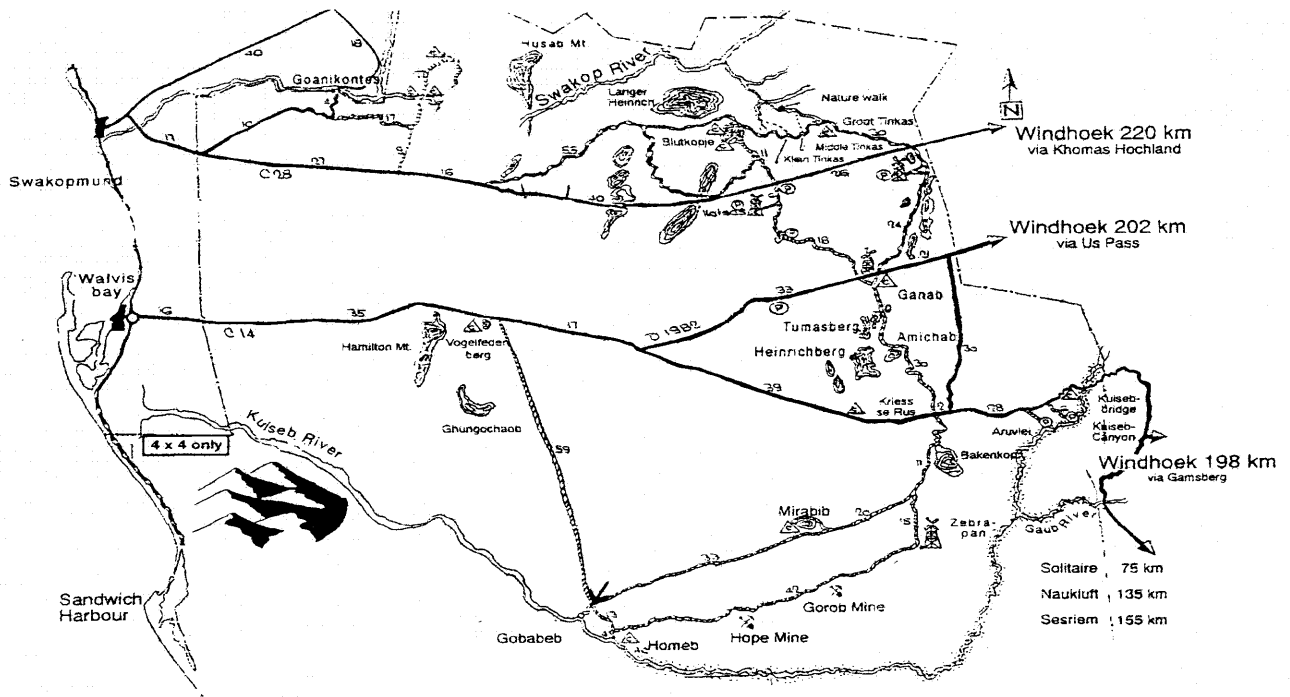


Directions by road



From **Walvis Bay**, travel along the C14 for about 55 km – to just after the Vogelfederberg turn off – take the Gobabeb/Homeb road right. Gobabeb is another 60 km straight along this road.

From **Windhoek via the Gamsberg Pass**, turn right towards Walvis Bay once you reach the C14, drive through the Kuiseb Canyon, past the two (left hand) turnoffs to the Kuiseb lookout and Aruvlei - the third left turn is marked Zebra Pan/Mirabeb/Homeb/Gobabeb - these signs are on stone and easily missed, look carefully. In the distance you will see the Microwave Tower on top of a hill. At the Zebra Pan junction, take the Mirabeb/Gobabeb road. From the C14, it is 65 km to Gobabeb.

Please note that Park rules prohibit driving in the Park between sunset and sunrise
